The City of Dawson Recreation Department invites you to participate in our Commemorative Bench Program.

This program has been established to increase public enjoyment and participation in our parks and green spaces.

Guidelines

People may participate in this program by making a donation of \$850. This will cover the cost of a locally handcrafted bench, a personalized brass plaque and installation by City staff.

The Recreation Department will make every effort to accommodate your location request. Installation locations include:

- the new Waterfront Park
- the dyke trail
- Minto Park
- Community Garden

We may also consider installation locations not included on this list.

Plaques

Included with your purchase is a 3" x 5" brass plaque that will be placed on the backrest of the bench. Each applicant will choose the wording to be engraved on the plaque.

Participation

Applications for the Commemorative Bench Program are accepted year round and benches will be placed between May - September of each year. Each application must complete the included form and return it to the Recreation Department.

Payment

The fee for each application is \$850. Payment can be made directly to the City of Dawson. Upon receipt of all fees and a completed application the City of Dawson will mail a certificate and a tax deductible receipt.
